[This room was excavated in 1896 by the Hyde Exploring Expedition. They found an assemblage of 174 whole ceramic vessels. Crown discovered residues of chocolate in cylinder jar fragments from Pueblo Bonito in 2009, the first evidence of chocolate north of the Mexican border. Chaco rituals may be connected to the ritual use of cacao in Mesoamerica]
